The maximum speed limit on Icelandic roads is 90 km/h

Gravel roads
Speed limit:
80 km/h

Paved roads
Speed limit: 90 km/h



**Buckle up
Drive safely
Speeding kills!**

At 120 km/h an 80 kg person weighs 18,5 tons.
Any kind of accident at this speed can result in serious injury.

At 140 km/h it is very hard to avoid an accident due to unexpected animals or narrow single lane bridges. A car accident at this speed is deadly.

Icelandic roads are not constructed for speeding. Drive safely, respect the speed limit and enjoy driving in Iceland.

The fine for speeding can be up to 1900 euros or more. The police may insist on an immediate payment.

The main risk factors on Icelandic roads:

- ▶ Unexpected animals
- ▶ Single lane bridges
- ▶ Gravel roads
